

PASA Interpretation

Question: The Planning, Policy, Interpretation Subcommittee received an interpretation request from Staff to PASA Section 7.2.4, “If the vote passes with one or more negative votes with reasons for those negative votes, the results shall be held in abeyance until the comments and attempts at resolution of comments (including those unresolved comments received in response to the formal ASHRAE public review (See Section 7.4.6)) are transmitted to all eligible voters and they are given an opportunity to change their vote, reaffirm their vote, or to vote.” The statement “held in abeyance” was questioned in regards to the timeline, when are votes held in abeyance?

Answer: PPIS found that “held in abeyance” means that you are really voting on publication contingent on a successful public review.
