INTERPRETATION IC 135-2012-20 OF ANSI/ASHRAE STANDARD 135-2012 BACnet® -A Data Communication Protocol for Building Automation and Control Networks

Reference: This request for interpretation refers to the requirements presented in ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 135-2012, Clause 12.11.39, regarding Optionality of COV_Increment in Active_COV_Subscriptions.

<u>Background</u>: This question comes from a BTL-WG discussion.

Clause 12.11.39 states that the COV_Increment field in entries of the Active_COV_Subscriptions property is optional.

There is no direction given in the standard as to why this field is optional. Is it optional so that it can be left out when there is no COV_Increment for a subscription (non-numeric property) or is optional completely at the discretion of the implementer (can be absent even if there is a COV_Increment associated with the subscription)?

<u>Interpretation:</u> The COV_Increment shall be included in an Active_COV_Subscriptions entry if the subscribed to property is numeric and a COV increment was included in the subscription request.

The COV_Increment shall not be included in an Active_COV_Subscriptions entry if the subscribed to property is non-numeric.

It is a local matter whether or not the COV_Increment is included in an Active_COV_Subscriptions entry if the subscribed to property is numeric and no COV increment was included in the subscription request.

Question: Is this Interpretation correct?
