Whereas, The American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) supports improving the energy performance of new and existing buildings, including through its research, standards, publishing and continuing education; and

Whereas, ANSI/ASHRAE/IES Standard 90.1 has served as the benchmark for commercial building energy codes in the United States and a key basis for codes and standards worldwide for over 35 years; and

Whereas, Improved energy codes for homes and commercial buildings also can significantly reduce utility costs and create new jobs, and City of Albuquerque supports increasing building energy efficiency through adoption of more up to date codes and standards, including ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2022 and the model 2024 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC); and

Whereas, A nationwide network of energy efficiency groups and partners has designated the first Wednesday in October as Energy Efficiency Day; and

Whereas, Together the residents of the city of Albuquerque can continue to contribute to our sustainability efforts by learning more about energy efficiency and practicing smarter energy use in their daily lives; and
