ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom, Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come — Greeting

WHEREAS energy efficient businesses employ tens of thousands of people in British Columbia and across Canada, and

WHEREAS improved energy efficiency helps people in households, businesses and institutions across British Columbia save money, be more competitive and have a better quality of life, and

WHEREAS energy efficiency is the cleanest way to meet increasing demand for energy, is good for the natural environment and is one of the lowest-cost ways to reduce British Columbia's greenhouse gas emissions, and

WHEREAS Energy Efficiency Day is an opportunity to learn more about energy efficiency and how to practice smarter energy use in everyday life;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 7, 2021, shall be known as

"Energy Efficiency Day"

in the Province of British Columbia.
