

Suggested Travel for Fairbanks

Airfare Discounts:

The conference has procured an airline discount code for travel on Alaska Airlines. This code is good for travel to and from both Anchorage and Fairbanks conferences. Note blackout dates will impact return flights from Fairbanks. Information is as follows:

Air Travel in Alaska:

Historically, a one hour pre-flight check in is all that is needed for Anchorage and Fairbanks airports. Note that ulus (traditional Alaska Native knife) must be put in checked baggage.

Anchorage to Fairbanks Travel

All Arctic Mini Conference attendees must be at Cold Climate Housing Research Center (CCHRC) by 1:00 pm Thursday, March 9th in order to board the bus for Chena Hot Springs.

Cold Climate Housing Research Center is located at 955 Draanjik Drive, Fairbanks, Alaska.

In addition to technical presentations and lunch at CCHRC from 11:30 to 1:00, there are also technical site tours planned for Thursday morning for conference attendees. Transportation to and from CCHRC for those site tours will start at 8:00 am and continue until the lunch program. To maximize the technical tour opportunities, Wednesday evening travel is recommended.

There will be a bus that will transport conference attendees from the airport to CCHRC for these three flights. Volunteers will be at the airport to direct conference attendees to the bus location.

Transportation To and From Chena Hot Springs

Conference registration includes bus travel from CCHRC to Chena Hot Springs on Thursday March 9. It is critical that all conference attendees and guests are registered for the conference to ensure there are enough seats on the buses. Conference attendees must be at CCHRC by 1:00 pm for a timely bus departure.

A conference bus will be leaving Chena Hot Springs at 4:30 pm on Friday March 10. The bus will drop conference attendees off at the Fairbanks International Airport.

Fairbanks Departure Travel

The conference includes bus transportation from Chena Hot Springs to Fairbanks International Airport. Conference attendees that want to spend additional time in Chena Hot Springs should arrange for alternate transportation from the resort.

Based on potential winter weather driving conditions, we are recommending that conference attendees reserve departure flights AFTER 7:30 pm on Friday, March 10, 2023.

Car Rental Recommendations:

Though air travel and conference provided transportation is what is recommended, some visitors may wish to rent a vehicle for additional exploration outside of the conference.

Traditional/National rental companies in both Anchorage and Fairbanks do not come with winter driving rated tires. If conference attendees want to rent a car in Fairbanks, it is highly recommended that they use a rental service such as Turo where they are renting vehicles from Alaskans that have been outfitted for winter driving conditions. Ensure that the vehicles have studded or winter tires. "All-season" tires are typically not enough. Vehicle rentals for travel outside of Fairbanks are highly recommended to be four-wheel drive, or at least all-wheel drive.
