# User Tip #6: Building EQ System Outputs August 2019

The Building EQ Portal has a number of system outputs available to assist building owners, assessors, and energy consulting firms in presenting information from the assessments in order to improve a building's energy performance. The available system outputs include:

## **User Input Report**

- Recap of all data entered into the Portal
- Blank report available for use of data collection offline
- FREE to all users

### **Calculated Building EQ Performance Score**

- Visible at top of online Portal page after input of minimum required data
- Indicates your building's energy performance as compared to similar buildings
- FREE to all users

## **Building EQ Label Report**

- Graphic representation of Building EQ score on a barometer scale
- PDF file can be used to create a building plaque for display
- FREE to credentialed users for approved submissions

#### **Building EQ Narrative Audit Report**

- Customizable MS Word Level 1 Energy Audit report template
- Meets ASHRAE Standard 211 reporting requirements
- Auto populates In Operation assessment data from Portal into report
- · Can be edited and tailored to distinguish/brand an Assessor or their firm
- Saves report preparation time for Assessor and provides a consistent format for assessment and audit information
- \$200 to credentialed users for each approved submission

#### **Building EQ Spreadsheets Audit Report**

- ASHRAE Standard 211 Level 1 Energy Audit worksheets in MS Excel format
- Auto populates In Operation assessment data from Portal into report
- Additional information entered by user
- Can be used as an attachment to a narrative audit report
- \$50 to credentialed users for each approved submission

#### **Building EQ Disclosure Report**

- Presents key energy information and Building EQ Performance Score
- Provides documentation for disclosure ordinances
- Suitable for real estate transaction energy disclosure
- \$50 to credentialed users for each approved submission
