30-day Public Review from August 14, 2026 to September 13, 2026

- ♦ **First Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum *r* to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 62.2-2025, *Ventilation and Acceptable Indoor Air Quality in Residential Buildings***

This addendum would broaden the scope of Standard 62.2 to cover spaces adjacent to dwelling units that are not covered by other ASHRAE standards (i.e., ASHRAE Standard 62.1 or ASHRAE/ASHE Standard 170).

45-day Public Review from August 14, 2026 to September 28, 2026

- ♦ **Second Independent Substantive Change, Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum *c* to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 140-2023, *Method of Test for Evaluating Building Performance Simulation Software***

This addendum updates the Standard 140 acceptance criteria based on updated results from Building Energy Modeling software. The same procedure that was used for the existing ranges was used with the new results to calculate the updated ranges. One software, the Modelica Buildings Library, was added to the reference set of software for the calculations.
