- ♦ **First Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Standard 41.11-2023R, *Standard Methods for Power Measurement***

This revision of Standard 41.11-2023 prescribes methods for power measurements. This version of the standard includes updated methods for determining when steady-state operation has been achieved for data recording, as well as changes to make it easier for higher-tier standards to adopt this standard by reference. This standard meets ASHRAE's mandatory language requirements.
