- ♦ **First Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum u to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 15-2024, *Safety Standard for Refrigeration Systems***

This addendum addresses clean up in sections 7, 8, and 9 of the standard including permissive language and Machine Guarding reference.

- ♦ **Second Public Review (Independent Substantive Change) of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum q to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 15-2024, *Safety Standard for Refrigeration Systems***

This ISC adds clarification and units to the constant "1000" in equation 7-3, 7-7b, 7-8, 7-11a and 7-11b. Additionally, informative language including an example are added to appendix A.

- ♦ **Second Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum d to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 15.2-2024, *Safety Standard for Refrigeration Systems in Residential Applications***

This addendum addresses requirements for installation of refrigeration systems in an isolated space because refrigeration systems with a refrigerant charge less than ml need to be evaluated when installed in an isolated space.

- ♦ **ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 128-2026, *Method of Rating Portable Air Conditioners***
