- ♦ **First Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE/IES Addendum *dr* to ANSI/ASHRAE/IES Standard 90.1-2022 *Energy Standard for Sites and Buildings Except Low-Rise Residential Buildings***

This addendum updates the heat and energy recovery ventilator requirements, including cost effective increases in the fan efficacy and sensible recovery efficiency requirements.

- ♦ **Second Public Review ISC of BSR/ASHRAE/IES Addendum *bx* to ANSI/ASHRAE/IES Standard 90.1-2022 *Energy Standard for Sites and Buildings Except Low-Rise Residential Buildings***

This is a second public review of proposed changes to the laboratory exhaust requirements in Section 6.5.7.3. The updated proposal incorporates feedback from first public review comments. Commenters pointed out opportunities to clarify language and accommodate a wider variety of labs, which led to new definitions and some additional exceptions for the heat recovery requirements. The originally proposed reheat limitations have also been removed.

- ♦ **First Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum *b* to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 154-2022, *Ventilation for Commercial Cooking Operations***

This addendum brings awareness and better clarity and understanding to specifying engineers, duct installers, and code officials that a UL 1978 listed grease duct requires the inner wall grease duct material to be stainless steel in contrast to mild carbon steel that's permitted by unlisted code construction.
