• 1st Publication Public Review of BSR/ASHRAE Addendum b to Standard 30-2019, *Method of Testing Liquid Chillers*

This addendum changes "water" to "liquid" where applica-

ble; clarifies requirements for Δp_{adj} ; replaces reference to ASME and ISA standards with exclusive reference to ASHRAE 41 series standards; adds an Excel workbook to facilitate calculates in accordance with Table 6-2; and removes ft H20 from the standard.
