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FOREWORD

Addendum i adds the zeotropic refrigerant blend R-475B to Tables 4-2 and D-2.

LFL = 80,000 ppm v/v; 23.0 lb/1000 ft³; 370 g/m³

Composition (Mass %) = R-1234yf/134a/1234ze(E) (35.4/10.1/54.5)

Average Relative Molar Mass = 112.7 g/mol

Bubble Point (°F) = -15.3

Dew Point (°F) = -13.9

Bubble Point (°C) = -26.3

Dew Point (°C) = -25.5
