## INTERPRETATION IC 135-2020-23 OF ANSI/ASHRAE STANDARD 135-2020 BACnet® -A Data Communication Protocol for Building Automation and Control Networks

**Reference:** This request for interpretation refers to ANSI/ASHRAE Standard 135-2020, Clause 13.13 –LifeSafetyOperation Service and the definition of notification appliance in this clause.

**Background:** The purpose of the LifeSafetyOperation service, specified in Clause 13.13, is to allow a human operator to silence or unsilence audible or visual notification appliances and reset latched notification appliances. The standard does not define what a 'notification appliance' is or how it interacts with the device accepting the LifeSafetyOperation service request.

Audible is defined as "able to be heard". Visual is defined as "relating to seeing".

<u>Interpretation:</u> Within the context of the LifeSafetyOperation service, it is a local matter what a 'notification appliance' is and how it is controlled by the device accepting a LifeSafetyOperation service request.

**Question:** Is this Interpretation correct?

**Answer:** Yes
